

'Get A Divorce' Lawyer Stars In Racy Billboard, Playboy

Fetman: 'I Shouldn't Be Punished For Having Brains, Body'

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CHICAGO -- If the racy "Life Is Short, Get A Divorce" billboards didn't draw your attention to Corri Fetman and her divorce law practice, maybe her new venture with Playboy will.

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Fetman revealed this week that not only is she the new "Lawyer of Love" columnist at Playboy.com, but she was the scantily clad female body that posed for the billboard. The male body was that of her personal trainer, she said.

Fetman debuted on the Web site Friday, promoting her column with a nude pictorial.

"It was the best time I ever had with my clothes on or off," Fetman, 44, told the Chicago Sun-Times about her photo shoot. "This was a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity to pose for the premiere men's magazine in the world."

Fetman's now trying to get out a new billboard, featuring a woman in a dominatrix outfit, saying, "Take Control. Get A Divorce," the Sun-Times reported.
